



## Trails, Parks, Picnics, Nature, & Birding



Allen Acres Native Ventures, Dr. Charles Allen, author of several books devoted to native Louisiana flora, and his wife Susan, have spent years developing the gardens to attract butterflies and hummingbirds. Other gardens focus on various curiosities, such as night-blooming flowers, bird watching, and "yard art". Trails lead into the forest where trees are labeled for identification. Plant Identification Walks and/or Workshops are available on demand for groups of five or more -- with or without a room. Options include an outdoor tour, indoor workshop, or both. Wolf Rock Cave, Only known cave in Louisiana used by its early people as a rock shelter. It dates to 2500-1000 BC. Some archaic people lived here for short periods of time. The cave is located just a short distance from the parking area down a scenic trail along Bundicks Creek, in the Vernon Unit of Kisatchie National Forest.
